Horus ePortfolio statement for Foundation Doctors completing the Foundation Programme in August 2016 in Foundation Schools in England

Introduction

As you know, from August 2017 all foundation doctors in England will be moved onto Horus and Health Education England (HEE) will terminate its contract with NHS Education for Scotland (NES) for the provision of the NES ePortfolio for foundation.

How will this affect you?

You will have read-only access to your foundation information through the NES ePortfolio for the duration of the 2016-17 training year. Your login details will be unchanged.

The Horus project team are working with the HEE and NES information teams to ensure you retain access to your foundation information held in the NES ePortfolio after the move to Horus. Once HEE makes the move to Horus, the way you access your foundation information currently held in the NES ePortfolio will change.

Further details will be available in early 2017 - all historic users of the NES ePortfolio in England will be contacted using the email address they have registered on the NES ePortfolio.

What can you do to prepare?

- 1. Ensure that the email address you have registered on the NES ePortfolio will remain accessible to you beyond your foundation training.
- 2. Once you have completed your foundation training you may want to download your portfolio to a pdf file and save it somewhere safe and accessible to you. Step by step instructions on how to do this can be found here.

However, please be assured that whatever solution HEE decides on regarding access to historic NES ePortfolio data, your information will remain safe and secure.
