Summary

- [Horus ePortfolio](#) being used by the majority of foundation doctors (FDs) in England during 2017-18 training year (FP2017)
- [Horus Support Site](#) being updated almost daily with [FAQs](#) and [general updates](#)
- Further features released during October and November; developments continue
- 490 non-trainee grade ([NTG](#)) doctors using HEE Horus to record their own competences
- Approximately 300 'out of synch' FDs remain on NES ePortfolio during FP2017
- [HEE FP e-portfolio archive](#) system ("the Archive") in regular use

Developments during October - November 2017

- Features released: Placement supervision group (PSG) feedback process; team assessment of behaviour (TAB) process; linking portfolio contents to the curriculum; deleting portfolio items; changing the placement/rotation a portfolio item belongs to; sending manual reminders to trainers/assessors; portfolio item completion – individual FD summaries; reporting on FD progress (admins only); up to date training version of Horus

Plans for December 2017 – January 2018

- Release outstanding features: ARCP, mandatory certificates, noticeboard, e-LfH linking, enhanced reporting

- Released 8 September 2017. Approximately 16,000 users have logged in since then.

- A few errors / bugs have been fixed. Helpdesk being monitored regularly.
