Summary

- Live: E-LfH data import into Horus, ES assessment of curriculum and further reporting
- ARCP: Trust / HEE foundation teams should now be starting to set up ARCP panels
- 2018-20 foundation doctor (FD) rotations: import process begun (will complete mid-June)
- NES ePortfolio will be closed to all HEE users on Weds 1 August 2018 (see <u>January 2018 update</u>).

Achievements during April and May 2018

- · Features released
 - <u>E-LfH data import into Horus</u> (11 April)
 - 25% of FDs have linked their e-LfH and Horus accounts
 - Only activity in the "Foundation (FND)" e-LfH programme during 2017-18 is imported
 - From August 2018 activity in any e-LfH programme will be imported
 - ARCP guidance published on Horus home page (12 April)
 - See 12 April 2018 entry on April 2018 Updates page
 - ES assessment of curriculum (19 April)
 - Known as the "Curriculum progress rating" form
 - Ratings appear on ARCP summary of evidence report
 - Reports
 - Mandatory certificates admin management page
 - · Core procedures
 - Form R
 - External documents
 - Pdf upload size limit increased to 4MB
 - Database improvements in document storage, to speed up upload and download

End and start of year processes

- ARCP **Action required**
 - o Educational supervisors should complete their assessment of each FD's curriculum coverage
 - o Trust / HEE foundation teams should now be starting to set up ARCP panels
 - o "Summary of evidence" report 'sign off' form can be completed (not mandatory)
 - Trust / HEE foundation teams should familiarise themselves with the Horus ARCP process
- 2018-20 F1F2 rotations import **No action required from trust / HEE foundation teams**
 - o 14 May: received allocation data from Oriel (via the UKFPO)
 - Late-May: preparing data for import
 - o Mid-June: import into Horus completed
- 2018-19 F2 rotations **Action required**
 - o For most foundation schools these are already in Horus (imported this time last year)
 - Trust / HEE foundation teams should (as appropriate)
 - check rotations are still correct
 - add any rotations that weren't created last year

- assign supervisors
- Trust / HEE foundation teams should finalise plans for when each 'out of synch' foundation doctor using the NES ePortfolio will stop and (if required) start using HEE Horus. **Action required**
 - NES ePortfolio will be closed to all HEE users on Weds 1 August 2018
 - Contact us if you need further guidance.

Development plans for May-July 2018

- Release further features:
 - List of forms with 'concerns' to be displayed at the end of the ARCP "summary of evidence" report
 - Interim solution full 'concerns' management processes will be developed for the new training year
 - ARCP reports
 - ARCP outcomes (can already be viewed in ARCP management this feature refers to an easily downloadable report)
 - F1CC/FPCC downloading
 - Download portfolio (for FDs)
 - May be August 2018

Archiving of 2017-18 NES ePortfolio information

- Similar to last year's process, NES ePortfolio will transfer all data collected during 2017-18 (by HEE out of synch foundation doctors) to HEE in early August 2018.
- This information will be migrated to the HEE FP E-portfolio Archive during August and will be available to users by mid-September 2018.
- HEE Foundation doctors currently using the NES ePortfolio should download their portfolio <u>by</u> <u>Tuesday 31 July 2018</u>.
